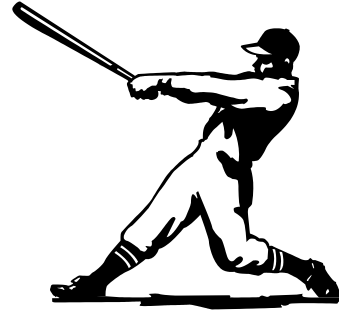


# Hasbrouck Heights 2009 Little League Baseball Information Sheet



Dear Parents

The Hasbrouck Heights Little League is a non-profit organization that relies heavily on volunteer support.

As a non-profit organization, the league is always in need of donations to keep the program running. We are **NOT AFFILIATED** with the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights or any other government source and receive only a small stipend from the Recreation Department (approx. \$775.00). We do receive support from the D.P.W. in the form of grass cutting that is greatly appreciated.

The League this year will raise funds from sponsor fees, door-to-door canvass, concession stand, Pancake breakfast/sports auction and a candy sale fund raiser.

## **COMMUNICATIONS**

All League information will be sent by email. The Hasbrouck Heights Little League website ([www.hhlittleleague.com](http://www.hhlittleleague.com)) will be another source of communication.

## **VOLUNTEERISM**

Hasbrouck Heights Little League is a **100%** volunteer organization managed by a 13 person Board of Directors and cannot function without the help of dedicated and committed parent volunteers. Each family is required to assist the league in conducting its baseball season to include volunteer participation with facility cleanup, field maintenance, concession stand, and all Fund Raising events.

## **DOOR TO DOOR CANVASS**

The League Managers and Coaches along with all the team players will drop off and pick up envelopes on specified weekends for this year's door to door canvass.

## **CONCESSION STAND**

Another source of income is our concession stand. For this to succeed, the cooperation of every Little League parent is needed. Each team manager along with the concession stand coordinator will organize its team's parents for concession stand duty. Every family must help when asked in order for this important undertaking to work efficiently. One person from each family is required to participate in one 4 hour shift (per player) as a concession volunteer. You are responsible to show up and stay for your entire shift to fulfill your concession stand obligation. This year the league will offer a concession less option, (**not recommended**) which will be **(\$50.00)** per player. The concession less option fee is due at the registration sign up. **This will be the only way to receive this option.** Please note: If concession less option is not taken and the family does not complete their duty, a \$50.00 fee will be added to the 2010 registration fee.

## **PANCAKE BREAKFAST / SPORTS AUCTION**

This year marks the 14<sup>th</sup> annual pancake breakfast/sports auction and is one of the best events of the year, Kids and parents alike look forward an array of sports memorabilia up for auction at the event. A lot of hard work is put into this event and many volunteers are needed for this function to be a success.

Four Pancake Breakfast tickets will be sent by mail to each Player (at no charge) sometime in January for the annual pancake breakfast/sports auction. (Date to be announced) More tickets may be purchased in advance at any upcoming General Little League meeting, though any board member or at the door the day of the event.

## **CANDY SALE**

This year's candy sale will feature a premium box of candy (all brand name), which all players are required to sell, unless the candy less option, (**\$40.00**) per player has been taken. (2 box limit per family) The candy less option fee is due at the registration sign up. **This will be the only way to receive this option.**

## **JANUARY MAILING**

By mail you will receive an information packet, Enclosed in this packet you will find four pancake breakfast tickets and a Little League Calendar with all the upcoming season events. Information such as field cleanups, Opening day, pancake breakfast, schedules, pictures, candy sale, field maintenance, picnic and other important information.

## **MONTHLY MEETINGS**

Monthly Little League meetings are held at **8:30 PM** on the **last Tuesday of each month** at Borough Hall (In Basement) we encourage everyone to attend. If you have any questions or are unhappy with something within the league, this is the place to bring it up!

We hope everyone has a great off-season and look forward to seeing you next season.
